✓ 75% successfully exited the program.

Of the graduates:

- 100% reduced their risk of Family and Domestic Violence
- 96% felt more empowered
- 96% increased their engagement with support services
- 92% improved their life skills
- 83% had improved ability to manage their household
- 26% improved their financial sustainability



Conclusion

- A successful exit nearly always results in positive changes in a client's life and successful ongoing tenancy
- Most clients have a low income so improved financial sustainability is difficult for them
