

# Outcare's Impact

The Social Impact Report includes results between July-December 2024.



## Outcare Consolidated Results

- ✓ 81% reduced or ceased their reoffending (sample = 249 people across 8 programs)
- ✓ 52% gained stable accommodation (sample = 62 people across 4 programs)
- ✓ 36% gained employment or a regular income or increased their employability (sample = 122 people across 3 programs)
- ✓ 61% increased their engagement with education/training or gained life skills (sample = 170 people across 5 programs)
- ✓ 72% reduced or ceased their misuse of alcohol and other drugs (sample = 74 people across 5 programs)
- ✓ 63% improved their relationships (sample = 104 people across 4 programs)



## Conclusions

Research found these outcomes led to reduced reoffending. Our data found:

- ✓ 81% who gained stable accommodation reduced their reoffending (sample = 32 people across 4 programs)
- ✓ 70% who gained employment or a regular income or increased their employability reduced their reoffending (sample = 44 people across 3 programs)
- ✓ 84% who increased their engagement with education/training or gained life skills reduced their reoffending (sample = 110 people across 5 programs)
- ✓ 83% who reduced or ceased their misuse of alcohol and other drugs reduced their reoffending (sample = 53 people across 5 programs)
- ✓ 89% who improved their relationships reduced their reoffending (sample = 66 people across 4 programs)
